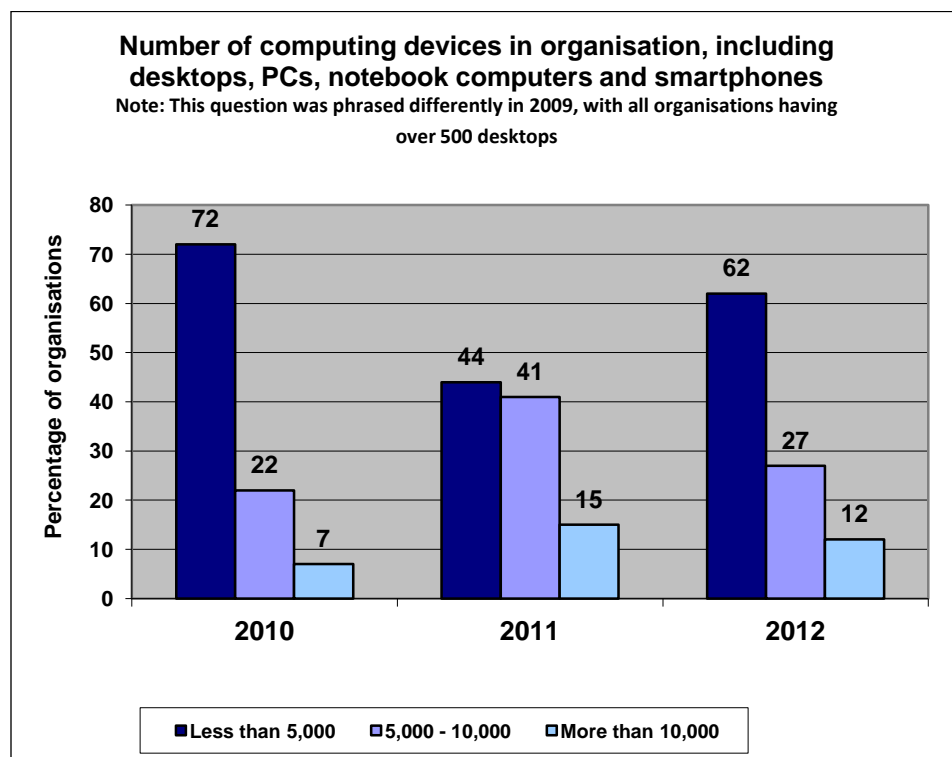


## IPv6 Task Force Top 100 CIO Survey: 2009 - 2012

**Note:** Each year, this survey is sent to New Zealand's Top 100 CIOs as ranked by MIS magazine<sup>1</sup>. In 2009, the response rate was 37 percent. In 2010, the response rate was 46 percent. In 2011 the response rate was 34 percent. In 2012, the response rate was 26 percent.

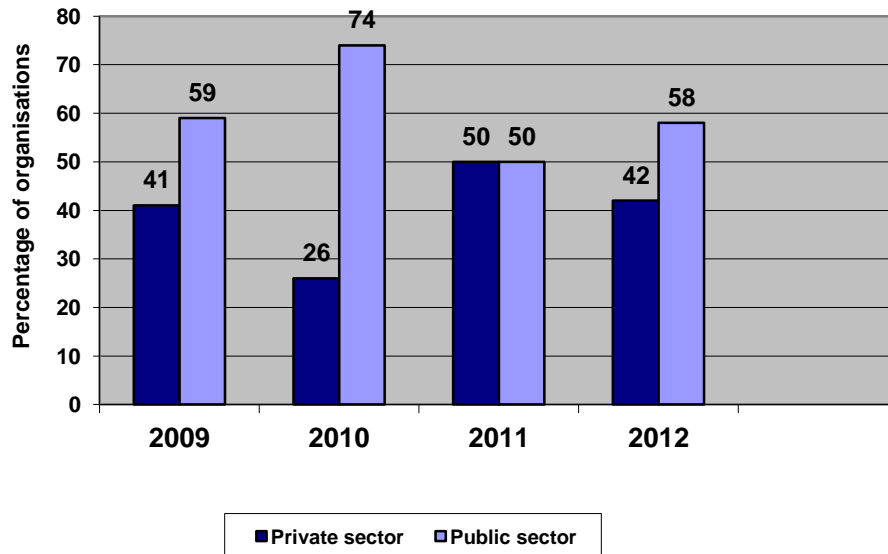

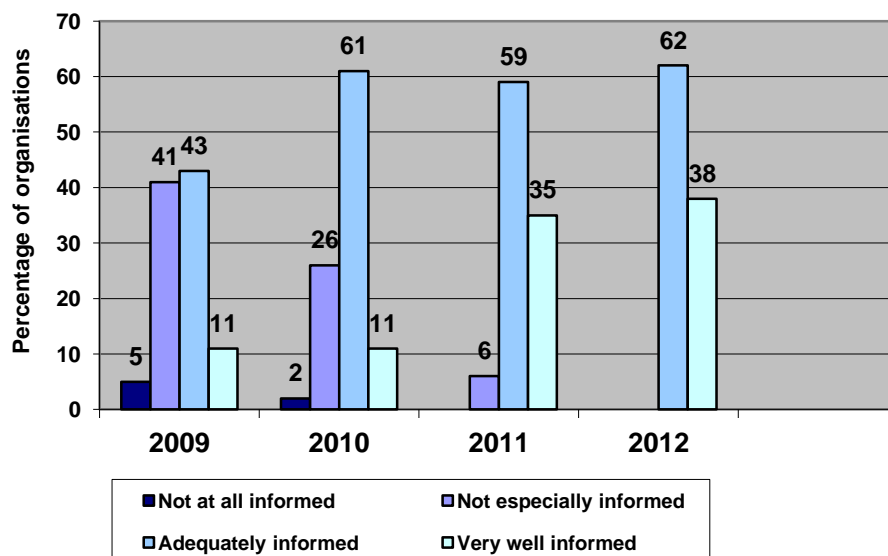

Is your organisation private or public sector?



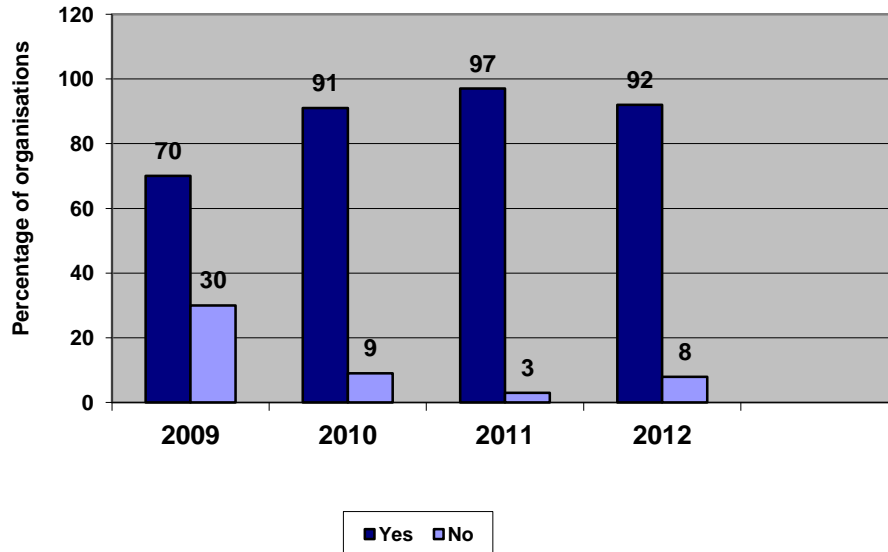
How well informed are you about IPv6 (what it is and how it works)?



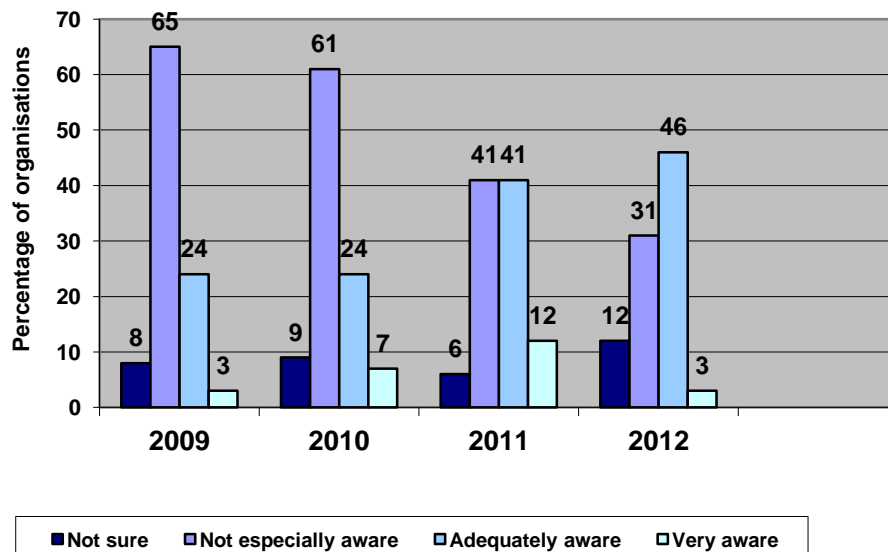

**Are you aware the pool of unused IPv4 addresses has effectively run out in the Asia Pacific region?**

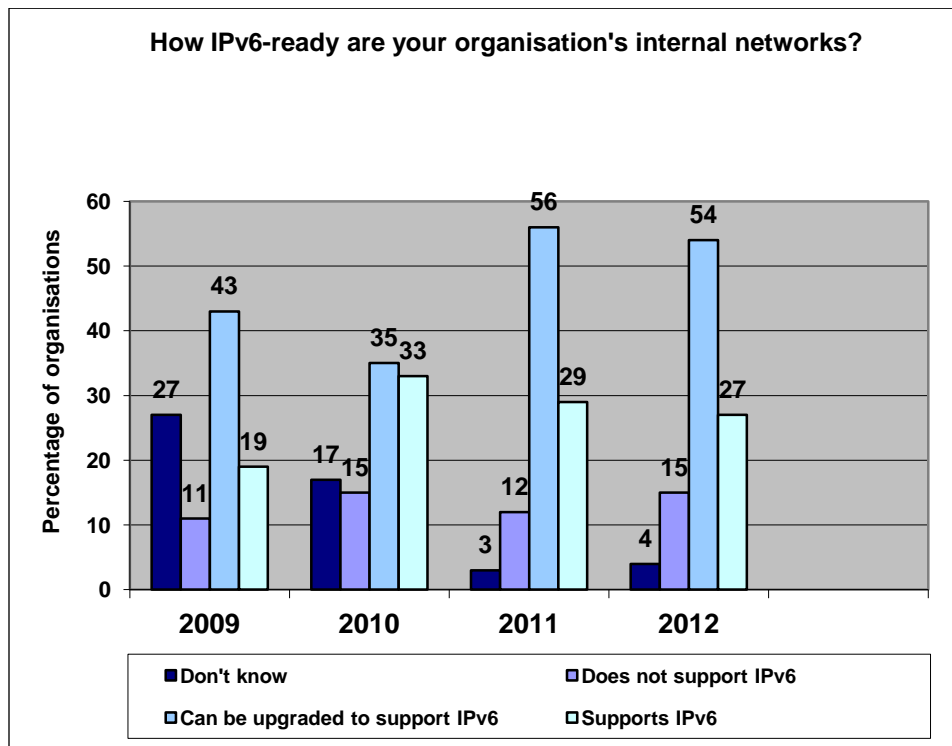
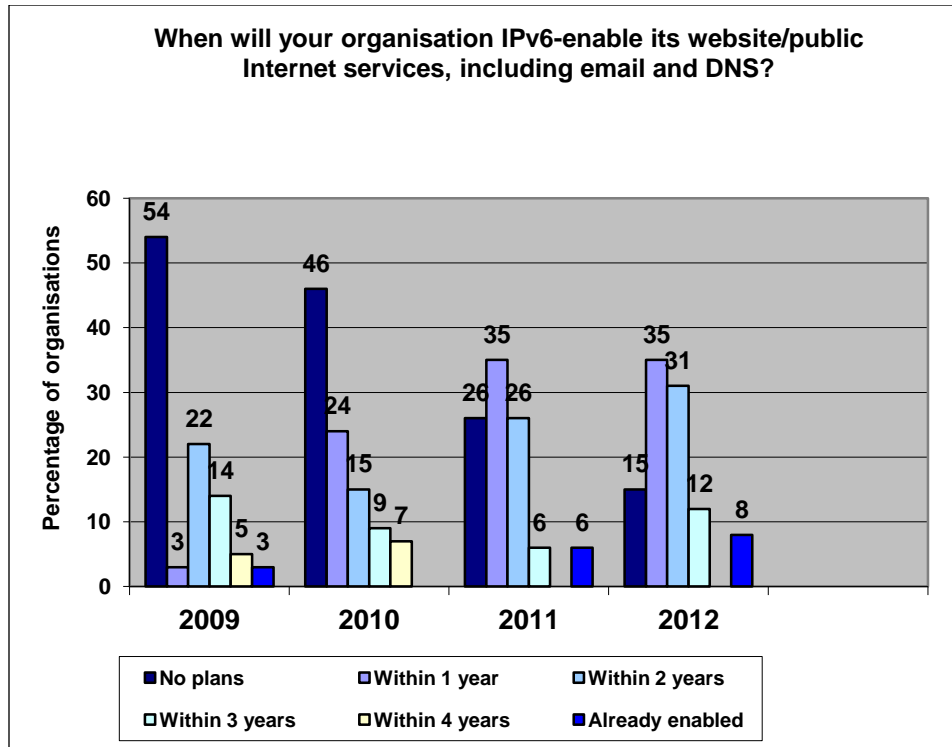

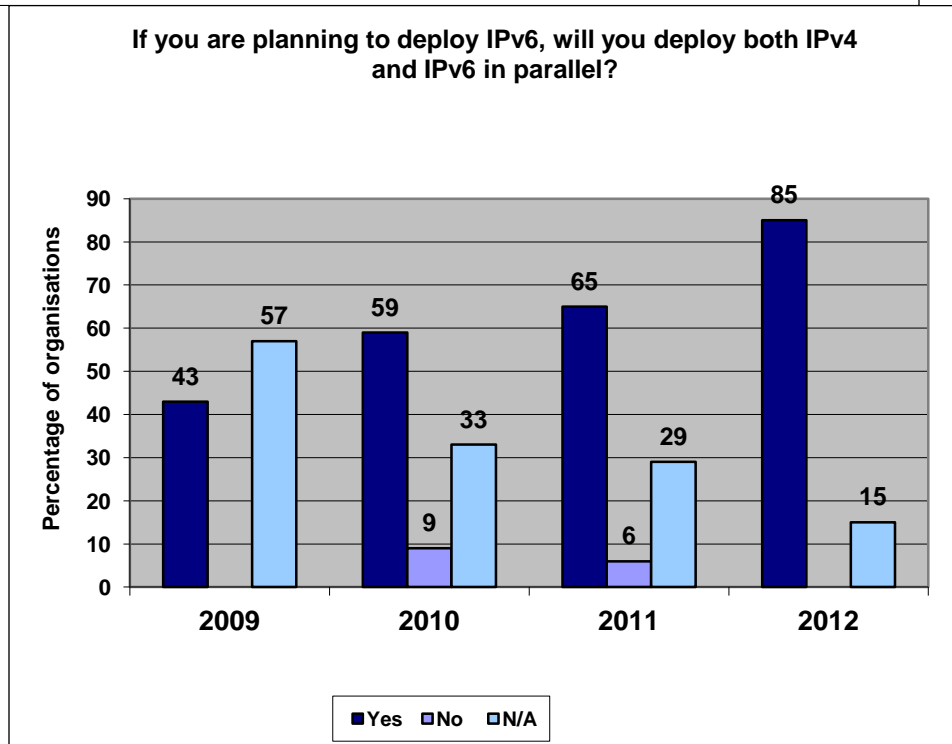
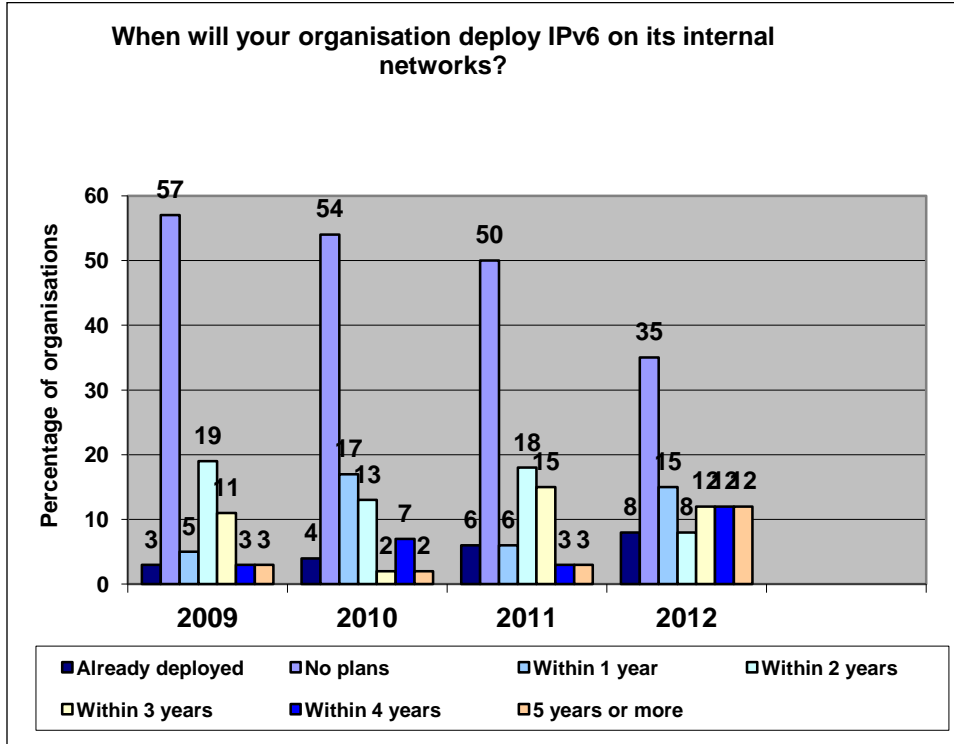
**How aware is the management at your organisation about IPv6 as a 'Risk/Opportunity'?**



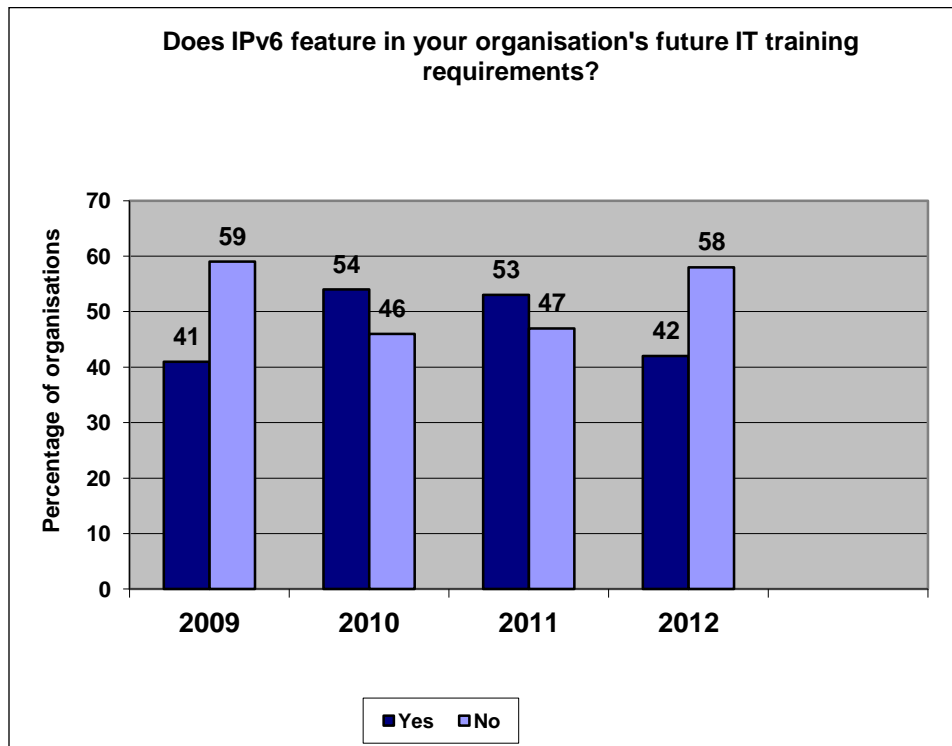
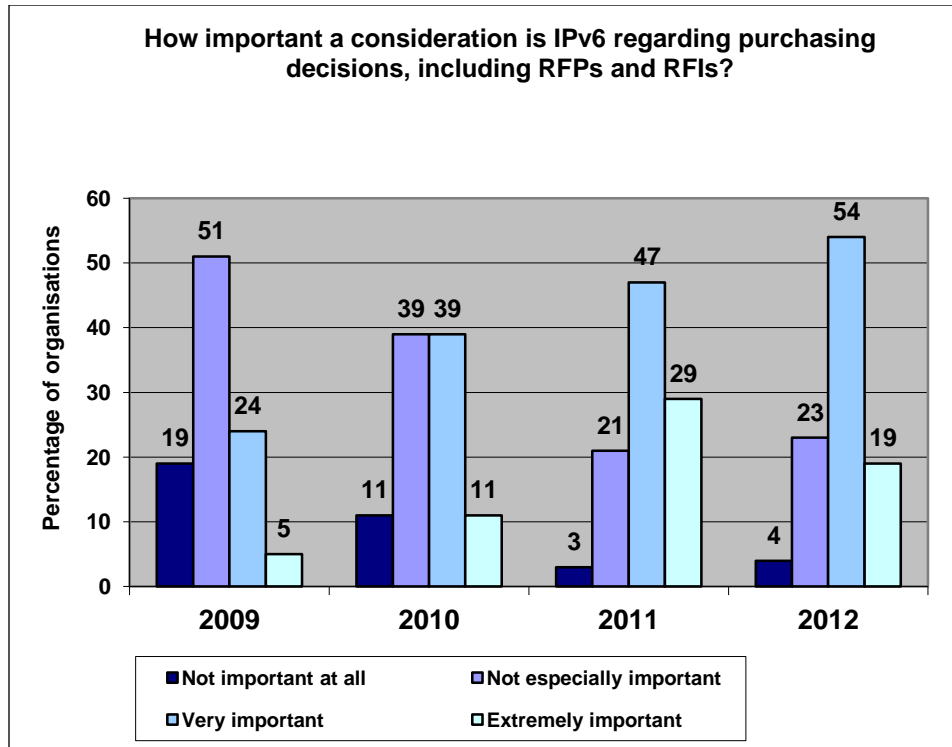

Note: this question was discontinued from 2011 and split out, asking specifically about 'inhouse' and 'outsourced' support

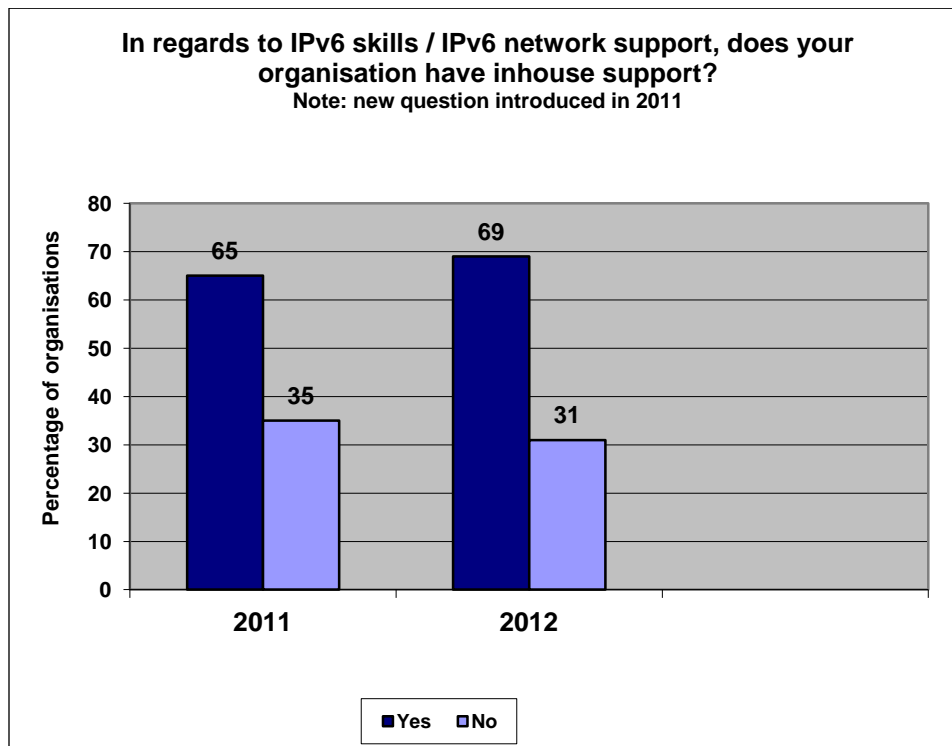
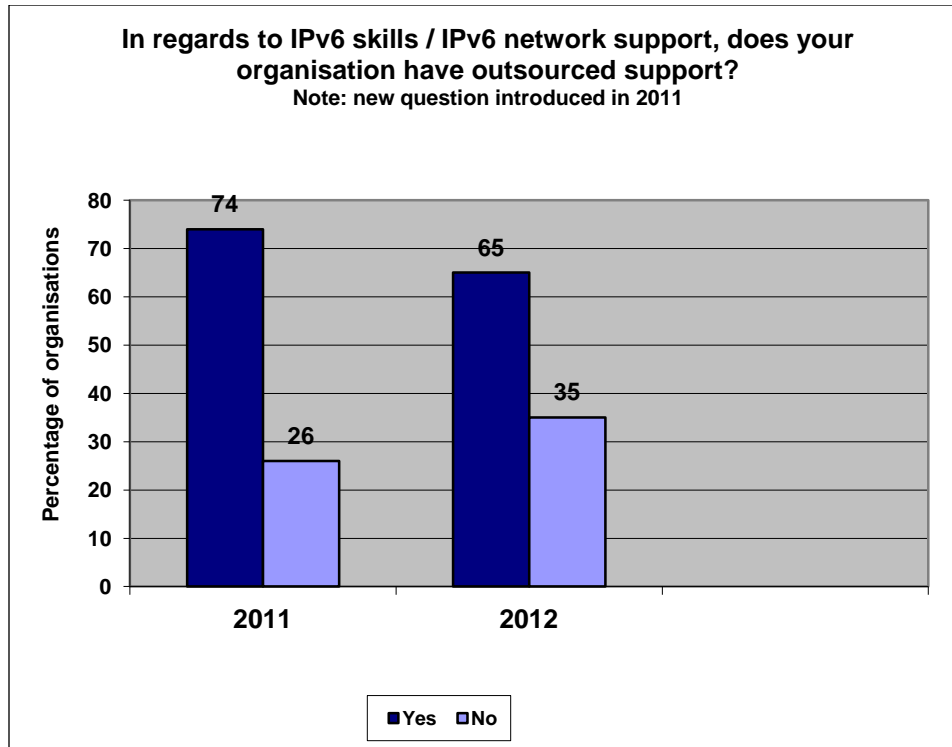
